- **Courses for New/Repeat Credit:** EPF; HPE 9; Geometry; Algebra 2; Honors Geometry; Spanish 2 and 3; and Algebra 1 (*for repeat credit only*)
- **Dates:** June 24 - July 24 (most courses)
- **Teachers:** 24 days, 7.5 hours a day
- **Tuition:** \$375, with sliding scale based on need
