Health Department Employees

- Mikyoung Moon Kim, RN Public Health Nurse who is responsible for developing a plan of care
 for students with chronic health conditions, Identifies and addresses medical and health
 concerns of students with parents, and for the supervision of the day-to-day operations of the
 health Room (clinic).
- Donna Long, SHA is the School Health Aide who is here each day while the students are in school. She delivers care to sick and injured students according to specific guidelines and/or care plans and administers medications.

Health Conditions

- Please be sure to completely fill out the **Emergency Care Card** AND the **Health Information Form**. This information will be shared only with staff members who need to know.
- Students occasionally need to be picked up from school. It is helpful for you to include the names of neighbors, friends or family members who would be able to do this on the Emergency Care Card in case you are unavailable on a given day.
- Keep your student home if they have any symptoms of illness.

Medications

- If medication needs to be given in school, either on a regular basis or occasionally as needed, it needs to be provided by the parents (no medications are on hand in school).
- Authorization forms for medications are available online at www.fcps.edu or can be picked up in the school Health Room. There are Medication Authorization, Virginia Asthma Action Plan, FCPS Asthma Authorization, and Authorization for Anaphylaxis Action Plan forms available.
- Parents can authorize over the counter medications for treatment of headache, muscle aches, orthodontic pain, or menstrual cramps. Most other medications need a health care provider's signature.
- Medications must be transported to and from school by a parent/guardian.
- Medications **must** be kept in the health room or other school approved location.
