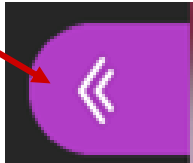

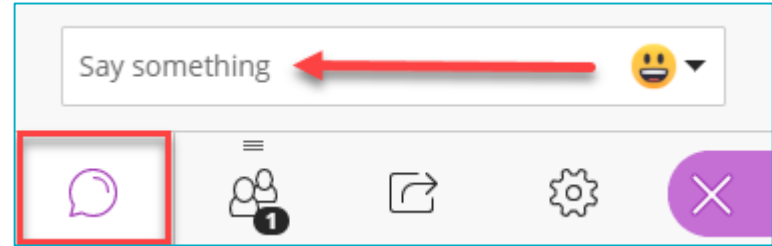

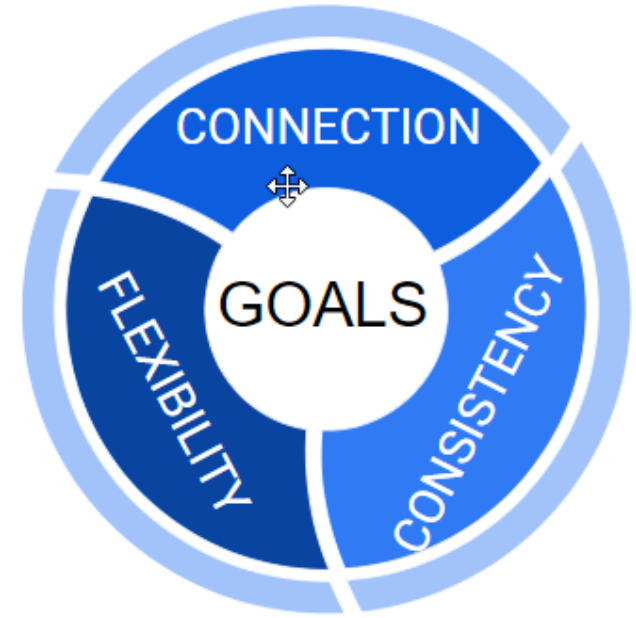
What is Distance Learning?

A learning experience where teachers and students are separated by place.

They communicate asynchronously through printed or electronic media and/or through technology that allows them to communicate synchronously.

What are we trying to accomplish for students?

- Consistent continuity of learning to the greatest degree possible
- Ongoing connections between teachers and peers and teachers and students
- Sense of normalcy and routine during a stressful time and allowing for flexibility of circumstances

3rd Quarter

- Close third quarter grades as of 3/13 (students given the opportunity for makeup work) until April 24th to calculate third quarter grade.
 - Any work, quizzes, and test from any point in the quarter can be made up
 - The teacher has the discretion to either provide make-up opportunities or to EXCUSE Grades.
 - “Do no harm” to student grade.

4th Quarter

- All FCPS students will be assigned a “no mark” for fourth quarter, but allow students’ work in 4th quarter to positively influence their final marks based on trends in mastery of learning

*Note: Only final grades show on transcripts; a “no mark” **will not show** on a student’s final transcript*

- Teachers and Counselors will have office hours Tuesdays and Thursdays where you or your child can ask questions. This time will be posted in their Blackboard courses.
- Teachers can be reached by email during the work week and will respond in a timely manner.
- Principal's Update will be sent out every Friday afternoon.

- Special Education Case Managers will be reaching out to share information with families.
- Adapted Curriculum will be sent home weekly and teachers will reach out to students.
- We will begin working on rescheduling previously canceled meetings after Spring Break. These will be in a virtual or phone call platform. (Transition IEPs, 504's)

What about my student's "stuff"?

Our focus right now is, of course, to keep our students, families, and staff safe, so we are limiting access to the building. There will be an opportunity at some point for students to come and clean out their lockers, but that will not happen for a while. Teachers know and understand that students likely do not have access to notebooks, etc. from their lockers.
