
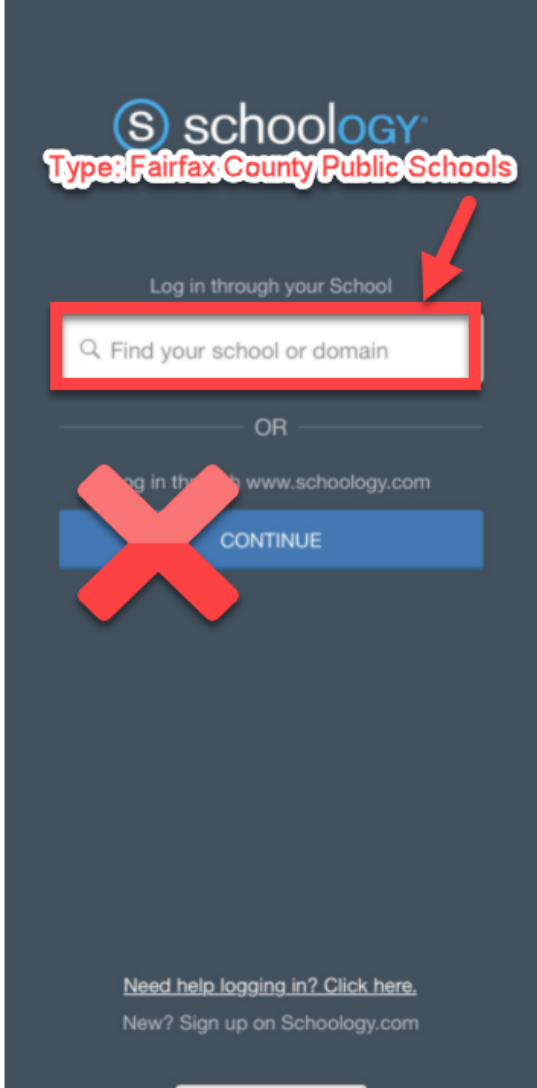


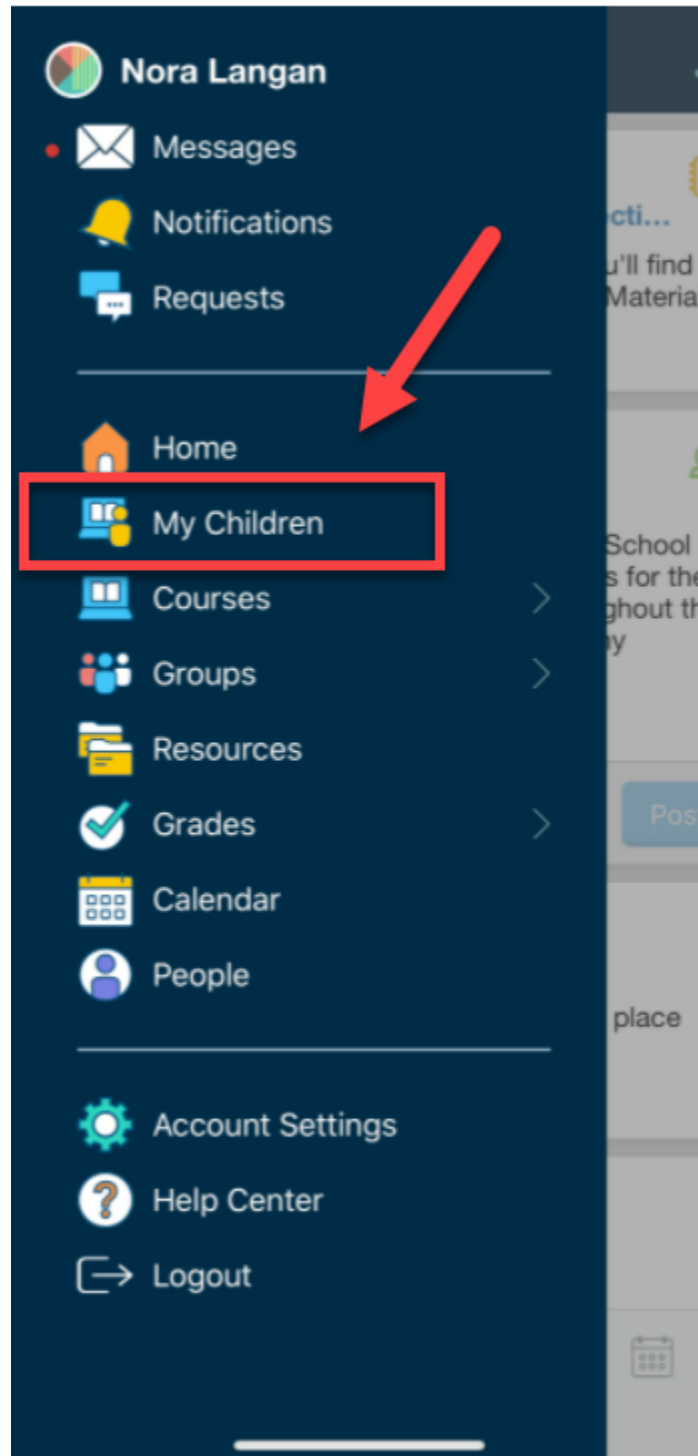
## How to Use the iOS Mobile App (Parents)

Step 1: Activate ParentVUE SIS Account	You will use the same username and log in for Schoology that you use for ParentVUE
Step 2: Download Schoology App from App Store. It's free!	
Step 3: Search for <b>Fairfax County Public Schools</b> (do not type the name of your school).	 <p>The screenshot shows the Schoology app interface. 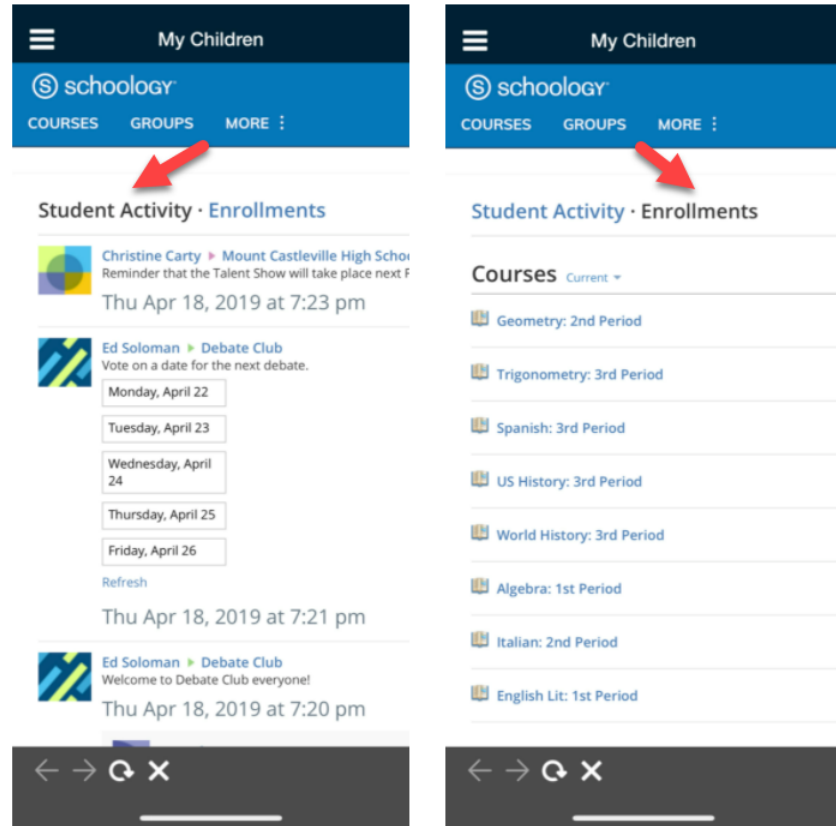
Step 6: View your child's courses

Click the top left corner to see the navigation menu. Then, choose "My Children." Here, you can view your child's activity in Schoology- courses, groups, and calendar.



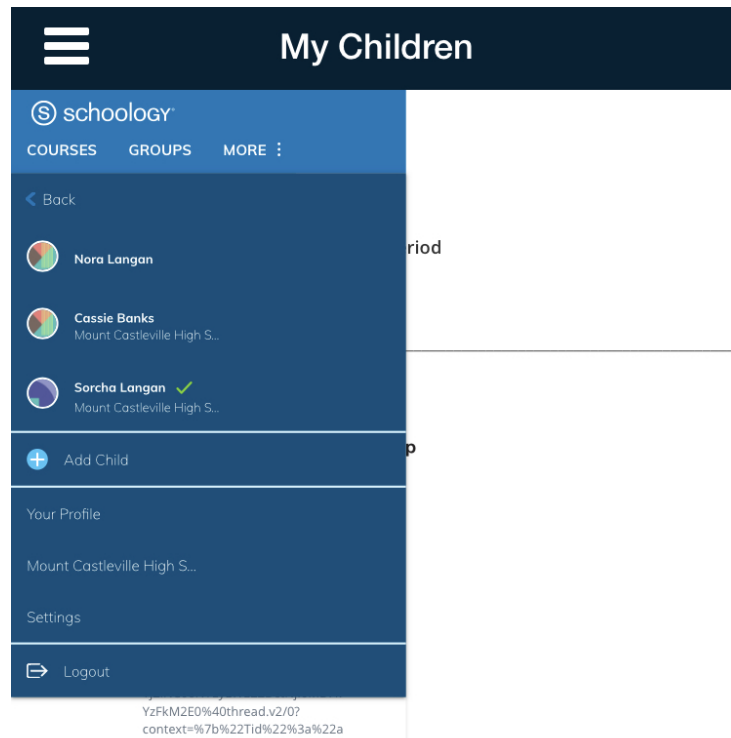
Step 7: Switch between Student Activity and Enrollments

From **My Children**, you can switch between **Student Activity** and **Enrollments** (to view courses).



Step 8: Switch between children if you have multiple children in FCPS

If you have multiple children, tap **More** in the header to switch to a different child's view.
